### IX. Research, Development and Applied Projects

Since 1990, my research and development work has focused on Radical Innovation and Paradigm Shifts in business, social, organizational, educational, and public management fields. This has been based on a Radical Constructivist philosophical platform, developed at DII since 1986, when Professor Humberto Maturana began teaching the "Biology of Knowledge" course for the department's graduate program.

This work led to the proposal to address the need to strengthen Social Capital, another area of research and development since the mid-1990s, through the creation of a new discipline I proposed called Sociotechnology. The Diplomas in Managerial Skills for Strengthening Social Capital and the Colloquiums on Strengthening Social Capital have been outcomes of this line of work.

This work has integrated Radical Constructivism with advances in Neuroscience—particularly in neuroplasticity—Systems Engineering, and emotional and spiritual approaches to education and innovation. Thus, we have developed a radical constructivist proposal for the Expansion of Self-Consciousness, one of the factors that most contributes to the well-being and holistic development of people in work, social, and personal domains.

Based on these pedagogical developments, work is currently underway on a proposal to create "Self Engineering" and "Engineering of Love".

At present, my main applied project is "Strengthening Social Capital and Generating a Culture of Innovation in the Aysén Coastal Region" (KAYSEN). Some of the initiatives cogenerated between the PIST team and various entities in that region have been taken on by the Puerto Aysén Development Corporation (CORPAYSEN). A master's student in Public Policy and Management at DIE applied for and won the position of manager of that organization in May 2023.

The project "Strengthening Social Capital in the State of Trujillo" is in its final phase. It began with an Extended On-Site Workshop (two days with 200 people) in 2007 and was reactivated during the pandemic in a telematic format. An important component of this project is the research "Cultural Pathologies in the State of Trujillo, Venezuela" carried out in collaboration with researchers from the Universidad de Los Andes, Venezuela.
